**Event Description:** 

Most bridges in the US are designed to accommodate seismic demands through inelastic deformations in the substructure elements. Specifically, plastic hinges in reinforced concrete bridge columns are expected to occur as a result of large lateral demands. This approach appears to be effective at accommodating seismic demands, but my result in significant column damage and excessive permanent deformations after a large seismic event. Such damage may restrict or prohibit vehicular loads on the bridge. Furthermore, bridge damage may not be economically repairable and may require that the structure with rebuilding a bridge may take years to complete, causing travel delays and economic losses.

Researchers and practitioners are developing innovative and resilient seismic systems aimed at improving seismic bridge response. Bridge columns employing high performance materials have demonstrated increased deformation capacity and less damage. Design strategies allowing for accelerated construction and reconstruction of bridges have been developed and are becoming common practice in several states. Isolation bearings and other energy dissipating devices first used for seismic retrofit are being employed in new construction. The focus of the papers on this topic are to present research findings and recommendations for the utilization of these innovative materials and systems to improve the seismic performance of highway bridges.
